

Notice of Intent to Increase Levy

NOTICE OF INTENT TO IMPOSE AN INCREASE/ DECREASE IN LEVIES HALL SCHOOL DISTRICT 8

March 24, 2026

The Hall Elementary School District Board of Trustees is authorized by law to impose permissive levies to support its budget. Per Senate Bill 307, state law requires the District to provide notice of its intent to increase/decrease these permissive levies in the upcoming fiscal year.

The Hall School District estimates the following increases/decreases in revenues / mills for the funds noted below for the next school fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026:

In FY 2026 the District intends to use Building Reserve Fund revenue to address the following items:

- Any facility improvements and repairs outlined in 20-9-525, MCA. The District estimates that the State Major Maintenance funding structure will generate a total of \$42,875.00 in FY2026. The total State Major Maintenance levies are expected to be funded with \$8575.00 of local revenues and \$42,875.00 of State revenues. This Building Reserve Permissive Levy change is estimated to result in \$5.44 more/less on a \$100,000 home and \$16.31 more/less for a \$200,000 home. Please contact Jolene Burke, Dist.
